Summer Uniform

Dear Parents,

As we are now approaching the end of term I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the school's summer uniform for next term.

1. Pre-School

Boys should be in mid-grey coloured shorts, regulation red polo shirt and regulation grey socks.

Girls should be in the regulation summer dress and white ankle socks.

2. Infants (Reception, Year 1 & Year 2)

All children in the Infants are required to wear summer uniform from the May half term. However, boys are permitted to wear their summer uniform from the start of the summer term.

The summer uniform consists of:

- Mid-grey shorts with no pockets (cargo style shorts will not be allowed under any circumstances). These may be purchased anywhere so long as they conform with our uniform requirements. Our stockists, Pullens, also sell them.
- School regulation socks (grey with red stripe) – these will need to be purchased from Pullens. Only school socks are permitted.
- White shirt (boys may wear long or short sleeved shirts but not with buttoned collar tabs)
- Jumper
- Blazer and cap

3. Juniors (Years 3-6)

All children in the juniors are now actively encouraged to wear summer uniform for ease and comfort as we move into the warmer weather.

As with the infants, the summer uniform consists of:

- Mid-grey shorts with no pockets (cargo style shorts will not be allowed under any circumstances). These may be purchased anywhere so long as they conform with the uniform requirements. Our stockists, Pullens, also sell them.
- School regulation socks (grey with red stripe) – these will need to be purchased from Pullens. Only school socks are permitted.
- White shirt (boys may wear long or short sleeved shirts but not with buttoned collar tabs)
- Jumper
- Blazer and cap

4. Hats

Felt school caps must be worn for travelling to and from school (Year 6 are exempt). When the weather is hot and sunny the children may bring their summer caps to school so they can wear them in the playground/sports field during the day. However, the summer caps should **not be worn** on the journey to and from school. These summer caps can be purchased from the school office.

5. Haircuts

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you all about haircuts.

- Hair should be no shorter than Grade 2 and hair styles and lengths **must avoid extremes** and must not draw attention to the pupil.
- Tramlines, patterns and sculpting are not allowed.
- Hair should be one natural colour with no hair dye.
- The style should be appropriate for school and should not obstruct the pupil's vision.

Please may I politely remind you that, in line with school policy, any boy who attends school with an inappropriate haircut will be requested to stay away from school until such time as the hair has grown or has been appropriately restyled. As ardent believers in the full-time education of your child we would deeply regret your son missing valuable lessons when it could have been avoided.

All regulation BPS uniform items are available from Pullens. Uniform items may be ordered on Pullens' website and they will deliver these to school on a Friday. We can send these home with your child or you may come in to collect them.
