<p><b>LITERACY</b></p>	<p>Phonics: Continuing with phase 2 phonics and segmenting and blending cvc words.</p> <p>Reading:          Use repeated refrains from traditional tales          Re-enact traditional tales          Segment and blend cvc words          Begin to read the first 100 sight words          Continue a rhyming string          Describe main story settings, characters and events.          Show an awareness of how stories are structured.</p> <p>Writing:          Independently sound out and writing cvc words.          Write letters and maps linked to traditional tales.          Write name and surname</p>
<p><b>MATHS</b></p>	<p>Number:</p> <p>Order numbers to 20          Form numbers to 10          Know which numbers come before and after numbers to 10/20          Begin to use vocabulary involving adding and subtraction</p> <p>Shape Space and Measure:</p> <p>Order and sequence familiar events          Measure short periods of time in simple ways          Continue to learn about 2D shapes and their properties</p>
<p><b>PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT</b></p>	<p>Prepare for moving into Reception – anticipate changes in routine          Gain an understanding of feelings and discussions about what makes them feel happy, scared, sad, excited etc. (Using traditional tales.)          Explain own knowledge and understanding and ask other children questions          Understand that own actions affect others</p>



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<b>COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE</b>	Continue to use the correct tenses when talking Listen attentively to stories and anticipate key events Listen and respond to ideas expressed by others linked to traditional tales.
<b>UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD</b>	Understand that you can use the computer to look for information – making leaflets Program bee-bots Look at patterns in nature and their environment.
<b>EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN</b>	Construct with a purpose in mind – making a chair for baby bear, building a bridge for the billy goats to cross, building homes for the three little pigs Explore the effectiveness of different materials. Re-enact traditional tales Create simple representations of characters from traditional tales
<b>PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT</b>	Continue to do up their own zips and put jumpers on and off Attempt to cut up own food Travel with confidence and skill over obstacles.
<b>FRENCH</b>	We will be looking at the topics of nature, minibeasts and the weather.
